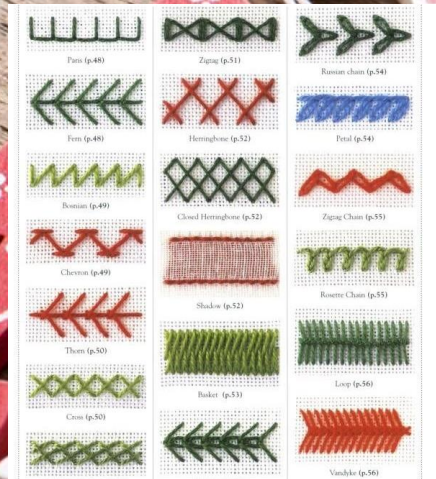


Year 5 - DT Knowledge Organiser - Textiles (Christmas themed)

- begin to pin and tack with increasing accuracy.

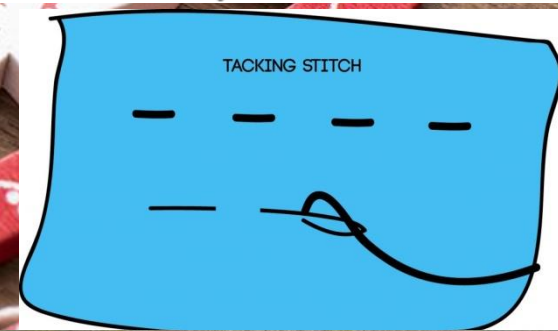
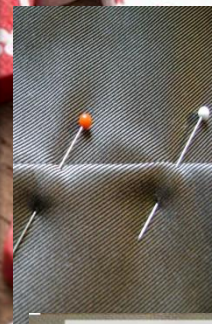
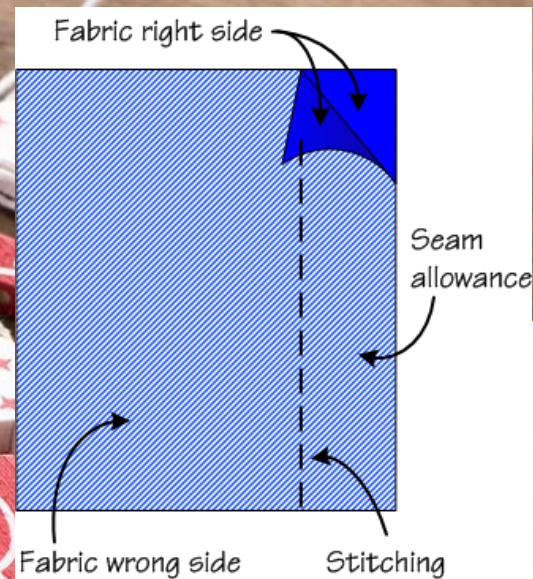

Key Vocabulary

Aesthetics	Colours, patterns texture of a product.
Design	To use existing products to plan, draw and label our own diagrams for what we are going to make.
Design Criteria	A set of targets that an end product must meet to be successful.
Evaluate	To say what was successful and what we could improve in our products.
Pin and tack	To pin pieces together and to sew temporary stitches that will be removed later
Research	To find ideas that will help you with your own design.
Seam allowance	The area between the fabric edge and the stitching line on two pieces of material being sewn together.
Textiles	The type of cloth or fabric being used.
User	The intended audience or person that the product is for.
