	<u>Challenge:</u>
Task 1	<p>I would like the children to be reading at home each evening. Each week the children take home 2/3 phonics books and a guided reading book. The children can read any of these throughout the week. This will help your child improve their fluency as well as their comprehension of each of the texts. If your child has read, please can this be written into the children's home-learning diary so that they can receive their house point.</p> <p>NB: Children do not need to read the whole book in one go.</p> 
Task 2	<p>This ½ term we are going to be working on our fluency in Maths. I would like the children to practise on NumBots to help with this. Login details can be found in the front of the children's home-learning diaries but if you need another copy please see myself or Mrs Guscott.</p> 
Task 3 - optional	<p>The title of our topic this half-term is 'Famous Queens'. This week we looked at Queen Victoria. Can you tell your grown up at home how many children she had?</p> <p>I would like the children either draw/ create a picture of Queen Victoria or find a fact out about her!</p> <p>The children can then share these at our show and tell on Thursday next week!
