




	<u>Challenge:</u>
<p>Task 1</p>	<p>I would like the children to be reading at home each evening. Each week the children take home 2/3 phonics books and a guided reading book. The children can read any of these throughout the week. This will help your child improve their fluency as well as their comprehension of each of the texts. If your child has read, please can this be written into the children's home-learning diary so that they can receive their house point. NB: Children do not need to read the whole book in one go.</p>
