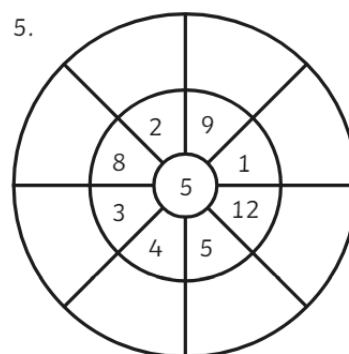
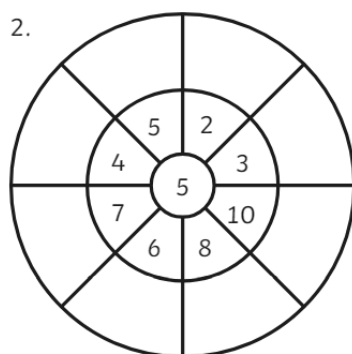
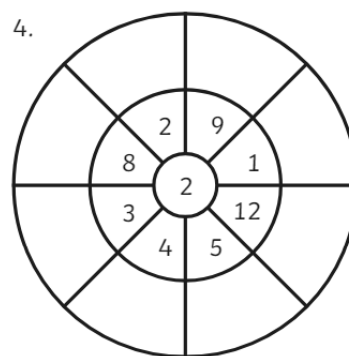
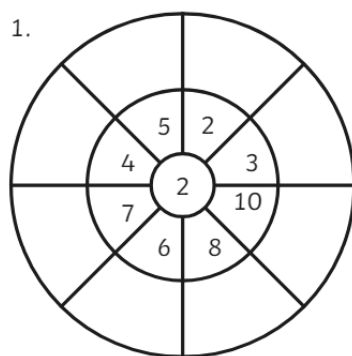
Task 1
