Visit to Bishops Wood, Stourport-on-Severn for Year 3 – Friday 12 July 2024



During their topic this term, Year 3 have been learning about the Stone Age. The trip to Bishops Wood will give the children an opportunity to learn about what it would have been like to live during this period of history. They will be able to discover first-hand what it was like to hunt and gather, learn the practical skills of the time, build a shelter and produce cave art. It will be a very hands-on day! The children will travel by coach, leaving school promptly at 9.00am and return in time for the end of the school day.

Children should wear school uniform tops with trousers or leggings. As this is an outdoor activity they will also need to wear trainers or wellies, depending on the weather. If warm weather is forecast, please ensure your child has sun cream on and brings a sun hat/cap with them. The children will need to bring a packed lunch, a snack and a drink with them. All lunches ordered via ParentPay will be cancelled, however if your child is in receipt of Free School Meals and you would like us to arrange a packed lunch for you, please contact Mrs Boulton in the school office by Friday 5 July.

Although school has subsidised this trip we need to request a contribution of £10.00 for each child towards the entrance and transport costs. Cheques should be made payable to Orchard Primary and Pre School. The children will not need to bring any other money in with them.

If you are able to help with the supervision of the children on this trip, please speak to the school office.
