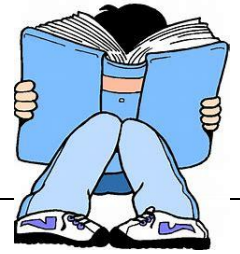

Homework Task:

Imagine you are a child living in either a Neolithic or Iron Age settlement.

You have discovered a magical stone that lets you write messages to children from the other time period!

 Your task is to either write a short diary entry or create a comic strip describing your daily life, including:

- Where you live (what your house looks like)
- What you eat and how you cook it
- What your clothes are made of
- The tools or weapons you use or see
- Who you live with and what your community is like
- What your day is like (e.g., chores, games, helping adults)

Then, write a reply from a child living in the *other* time period (Neolithic if your first diary was from Iron Age, or Iron Age if the first was Neolithic). This child is surprised at how different (or similar!) your lives are.
