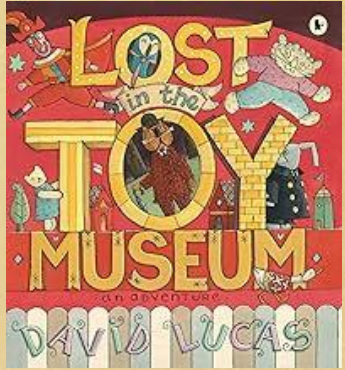
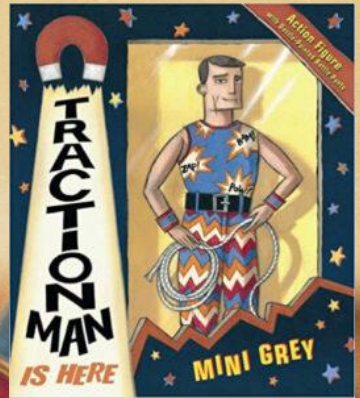
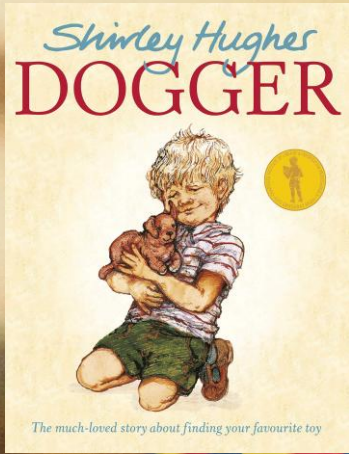

| Past           | Something that happened a long time ago.  |
| Present        | Something that is happening now.  |
| Artefact       | An object made by humans which is historically interesting.   |
| Change         | Something that is going to happen at a later time.  |
| Timeline       | A timeline is a tool that organises information. It is used to describe the order in which events happened. |
| Memory         | Something remembered from the past.   |
| Different      | How something is not the same as another.   |
| Similar        | How something is like something else.   |
| Invention      | A new thing that someone has made.  |
| Old            | Something that was made a long time ago.  |
| New            | Something that has been made recently.  |
