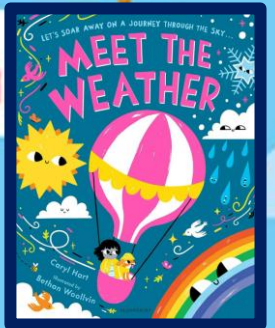
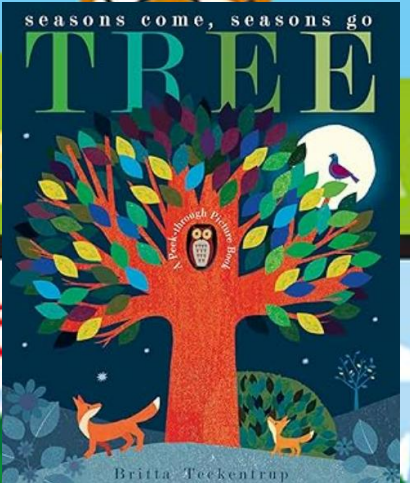
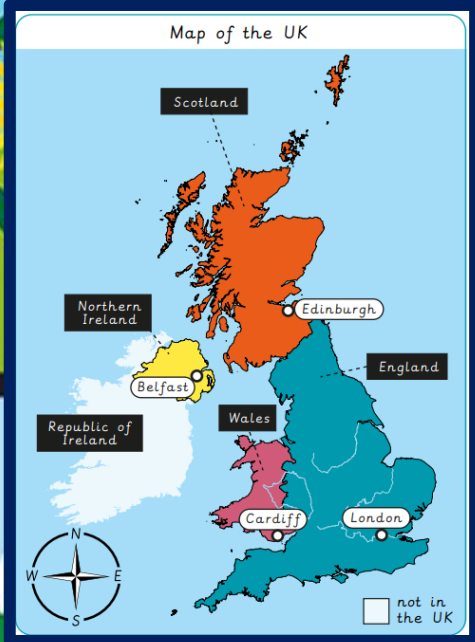

England	It is a country that is part of the United Kingdom.
Scotland	It is a country that is part of the United Kingdom.
Wales	It is a country that is part of the United Kingdom.
Northern Ireland	Is part of Ireland which is an island. It is the smallest of the four parts of the United Kingdom.
seasons	The seasons are four different times during the year with different types of weather. The seasons are spring, summer, autumn and winter.
weather	Weather describes what it is like outside at any given time of day.
atlas	It is a book that show a variety of different maps.
Europe	It is the second smallest of the world's seven continents.

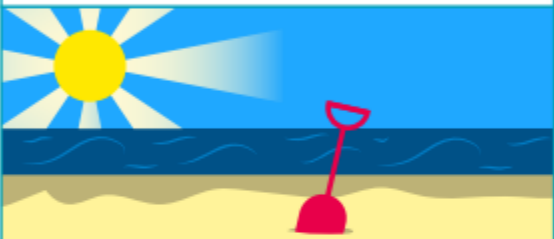

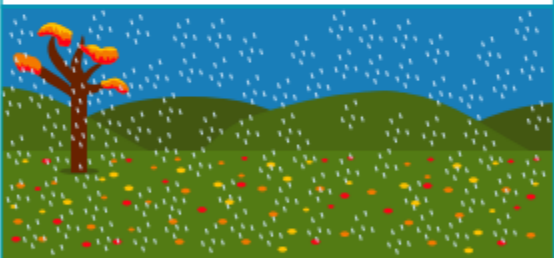

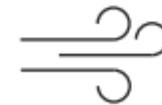
